Supplementary Regulations

Announcement - The West of England Motor Club will be holding a round of the above event which will be held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Trials Standing Regulations, together with these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued in accordance with TSR1.

Eligibility - Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration Card or a SACU Licence. Riders from other Federations must produce a licence and Start Permission confirming Insurance issued from their FMN.

Solo Class – Riders to have competed in the ACU British Solo Trials Championship, ACU Experts Championship, finished in the top 10 of the S3 parts series, been a Centre champion, in 2015 or 2016 or by invitation. Adult riders only.

Sidecar Class – Riders to have competed in the ACU British Sidecar Championship in 2015 or 2016, or by invitation.

Venue – Ruby Rocks, Ilsington, Devon, TQ13 9RT
(In the event of force majeure, the event will be run at Kelly Farm, Lustleigh)

Start Time – All riders to be signed on by 9.00am, at 9.30am observed practice will begin for solos and the sidecar trial will start.

Solo Format – All riders will complete 1 lap of practice, starting at 9.30am, with a 2 hour time limit. (Riders will be sent to various sections to avoid queuing). The results from the practice lap will decide the start order for the trial which will start at 12.00pm (TBC).

Solo Course - Will consist of a single course with sections of varying severity, suitable for the entry, between 12 and 20 sections, between 2 and 3 laps, with a 3 ½ hour time limit, all to be confirmed in the final instructions.

Sidecar Course - Will consist of 2 laps of 20 sections with a 3 ½ hour time limit.

Awards – The winner of the solo class will be awarded The British Experts Trophy, the winning sidecar rider and passenger will be awarded the Palmer Trophy and Feridex Trophy respectively. Prize money instead of awards will be awarded to 15th place in the solo class and 3rd place in the sidecar class. All finishers will receive a placing certificate.

Method of Marking – In accordance with TSR22B.

Entries - To be received by the Secretary of the meeting on or before the **28th June 2016** together with an entry fee of **£40.00 solos, £45 sidecars**. All cheques to be made payable to **West of England Motor Club**.

Final instructions and results – To be published on the club's website and Facebook page.

I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
