Notification of Entry & Final Instructions

Your entry for the above Trial has been accepted. Please note your start time, which is shown on the attached 'Entry List'

The start area is at Halton Gill, North Yorkshire. Postcode; BD23 5QN. Ordnance Survey Map 108 SD885765.

The coordinates of the start are; Latitude: 54.18482 Longitude: -2.18561

Park in Wilk's field and "sign on" at the start in Halton Gill, which is located 860m from the competitor's car park. **Bring your "Licence"**

Machine examination will commence at 09.00hours at the start, just outside the Village Hall/Reading Room.

Time allowance will be 6 hours: 30 minutes. **You will be timed off at or near the last section.**

Any new 'Final Instructions' will be displayed at the start.

The one lap course of 38 sections will be approximately 26 miles in length.

"Back Markers" will close the course and will be the last to ride the sections.

ADVISORY NOTE: Competitors concerned about running short on fuel are advised to deposit spare fuel, in an appropriate container, at Kettlewell Garage, before 10 AM on the day of the event. This fuel will be independently conveyed to Redmire Farm & will be available to competitors until the sections at this location are closed. Cans will then be returned to Kettlewell Garage for subsequent collection.

NB: It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their requirements for fuel are met.

Important Notice

For most of the route and all of the sections, private land is used; please do not prejudice its future inclusion in this and other trials by inconsiderate or inappropriate behaviour.

The use of this land today does not imply authority for access at other times without specific permission.

Excerpt from the ACU Handbook regarding the elements of the course which cross or use public rights of way.

"This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. Be especially careful near horses. Slow down, stop and switch off your engine if necessary"

Extracts from National Sporting Code 7.12 - Production of Competition Licence or Trials Registration.

7.12.4: If a late application for a Competition Licence or Trials Registration is approved by the Clerk of the Course and the Licence or Registration Fee is paid together with a fine for non-production of the Licence or Registration, described in Article 7.11.2, the competitor will be permitted to take part in the meeting.

7.12.5: **The Clerk of the Course and the Stewards of the Meeting have no power to permit an unlicensed rider or passenger to take part in a competition for which riders and passengers must be licensed.**

In line with National Sporting Code - Article 7.12.1; riders will be required to produce their current Competition Licence or Trials Registration when signing on at the start.

Now that riding numbers, as per the entry list, have been published there will be no refund of entry fees unless the event is postponed or cancelled.

NOTICE

North Yorkshire Police have advised that motorcycles used in this event should comply with all Road Traffic Act requirements. It must be understood by all competitors that whilst their vehicles are in use on a public road, they, like any other road user, may be subject to routine stop checks by police officers.

Other Information

Championship Course/Route: Classes:-

Class "A": All riders eligible for Championship points.

Class "B": Riders eligible for Championship points and riding a machine not exceeding 125cc.

Riders in this class are also eligible for points in the "125cc S3 Parts Championship".

Class "C": Riders not eligible for Championship points who wish to ride the Championship route through the sections.

Non-Championship Course/Route:

Class "D": Optional Non-Championship class with an easier route through up to 50% of the sections.

Throughout the day, excellent locally produced refreshments will be available at the start.
